Workshop Presenter - Expressions of Interest



Expressions of Interest are now open for arts workshop facilitators at the 2018 National Folk Festival, to be held in Canberra from 29 March – 2 April (the Easter long weekend).

Community Arts is a vibrant arts precinct at the Festival that welcomes all Festival attendees to get creative, participate and experience a wide range of activities on offer. Community Arts is open each day from 9am – 5pm.

## FREE ACTIVITIES

Attendees can drop in for half an hour to make a mark on our expansive and colourful mural boards, or stay for longer to contribute to a large ephemeral sculpture for the lantern parade, or join other creative folk to make a gorgeous art piece to take home in one of our free daily art experiences.

## WORKSHOPS

The Festival also offers structured workshops where participants can learn new skills from experienced artisans. Expressions of Interest for facilitators for these popular workshops are now open.

## HOW IT WORKS

- Community Arts is located outside on a large grassy area near the main entry gate.
- The Festival sets up large marquees for workshops, fitted with trestle table and chairs.
- Festival volunteers manage the booking of workshops and take payments.
- Workshop participants are charged a small fee to assist in covering costs. In the past this has been \$15 for an Introductory workshop of 1.5 hours, and \$20 for an advanced skills workshop of 2 hours.
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Workshop facilitators need to provide any materials and tools required for the workshop.
- The Festival provides 15amp power, but any power equipment used must be tested and tagged by a qualified electrician.
- When workshop facilitators arrive, they are met by Comm Arts volunteers and directed to their workshop space. They then present their fabulous workshop in a lively, welcoming and supportive manner!
